
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will continue to stabilise and will be well bonded throughout. Some accumulations of fresh snow may form small localised areas of soft wind slab, however these will be confined to high steep locations above 1000 metres and will be avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and in the day winds will be calm and variable, some light snow showers are expected. The freezing level at 950 metres will lower to 750 metres in the day.

Comments

Cool calm conditions - good climbing conditions continue to develop - all change Friday though, strong winds, high temperatures.
