

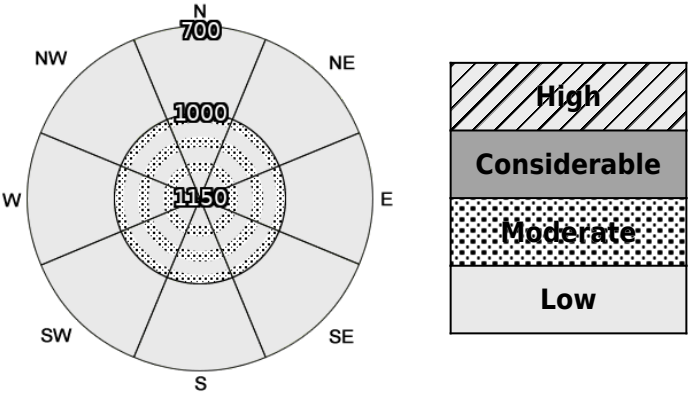

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 26/12/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The generally damp snowpack will further consolidate in the cooler conditions. Minor instabilities will exists in the shallow and localised areas of soft fresh windslab deposits on steep aspects above 1000 meters. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After some snow showers during the night, a dry day is expected. The freezing level will drop from 900 meters overnight to 750 meters during the day. Winds will be light and variable throughout the period.
