

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present, mainly on North-West through North and East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Localised pockets of thin windslab may be present on other aspects. The old snowpack will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After overnight snow showers above 800 metres, the day is expected to be dry. Winds will be light and variable. During the day the freezing level will lower to around 750 metres.

It felt like winter again at higher levels.
