

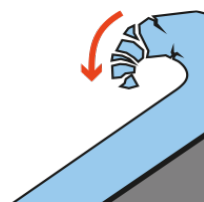

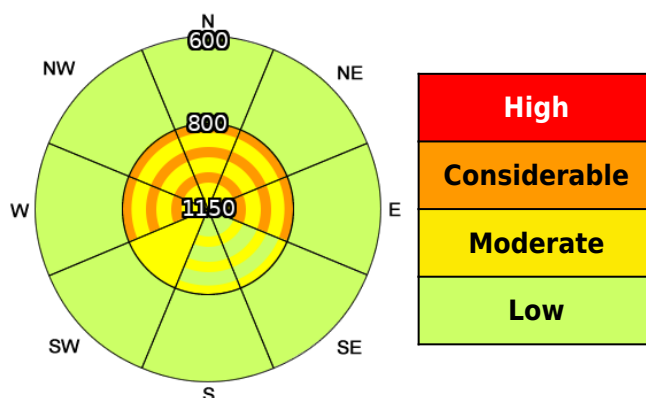
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight new accumulations will develop on mainly Westerly through Northerly to Easterly aspects above 800 metres. As the freezing level rises the snow will become increasingly unstable on all aspects particularly on steeper slopes. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will stay cold overnight before the freezing level lifts to well above the summits. There will be heavy rain accompanied by storm force winds from the South to South West.

Comments

It's likely to be a challenging day with heavy rain and 100 mph winds forecast.
