
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will start to refreeze and consolidate as the freezing level drops. Fresh unstable windslab will form in sheltered areas, mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Other aspects will also be affected due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Precipitation, initially rain at all levels, will gradually turn to snow above 700 metres as the freezing level drops to 900 metres. Winds are expected to be strong throughout, South-South-Westerly overnight, West-South-Westerly during the day.

Comments

A very mild day with summit temperatures reaching plus five degrees C. Colder temperatures forecast tomorrow.
