

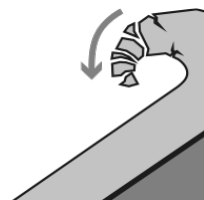

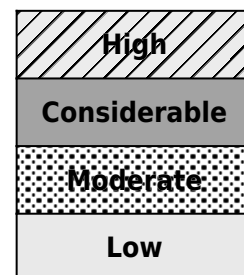
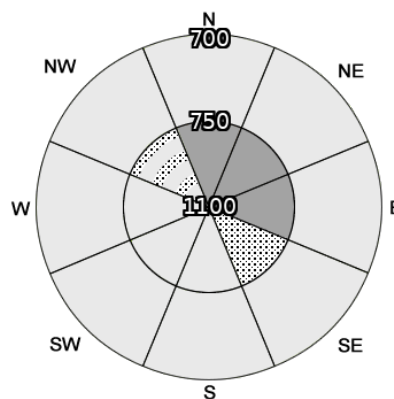
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly stabilised windslab will form on all North to East aspects above 750 metres where avalanches are likely. All newly formed cornices above these locations will be weak and prone to sudden collapse. The snowpack in many other places will become firm and show very good stability. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Significantly more wintry and colder weather throughout with frequent heavy snow showers overnight and during the day. Winds will be strong South-West, later West-South-West.
