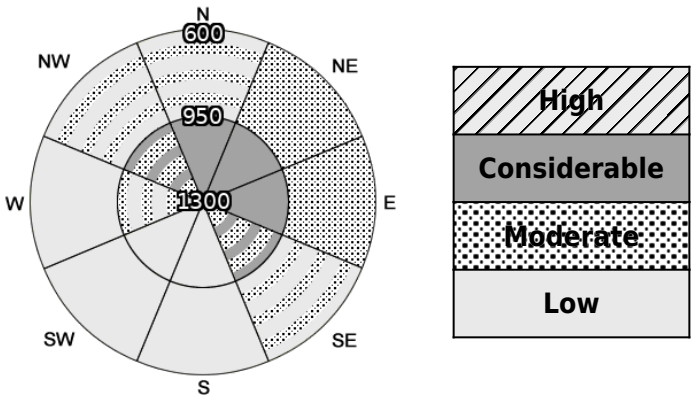

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of windslab will develop and avalanches are likely on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 950 metres especially around gully exits, scarp slopes and corrie rims. Pockets of instability will affect other aspects due to cross loading. Elsewhere the snowpack will remain firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be frequent snow showers on very strong South-West veering West-South-West winds. The freezing level will lower to around 600 metres.
