



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Other aspects will also be affected due to cross loading. The old snowpack will re-freeze and generally be stable. Fresh cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds are expected to be strong South-Westerly overnight then strengthening and West-South-Westerly during the day. Frequent snow showers above around 500 metres are expected throughout the forecast period. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.
