





**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be a period of high instability overnight as the thaw conditions become established. As the freezing level drops during the day, existing wet snow instabilities will consolidate. Fresh unstable windslab will form in sheltered locations, mainly on steep North-East to South-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Heavy rain at all levels overnight followed by colder conditions and snow showers during the day. Strong South-West winds overnight followed by Westerly winds during the day.
