

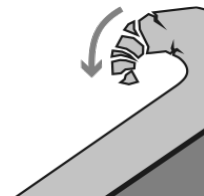

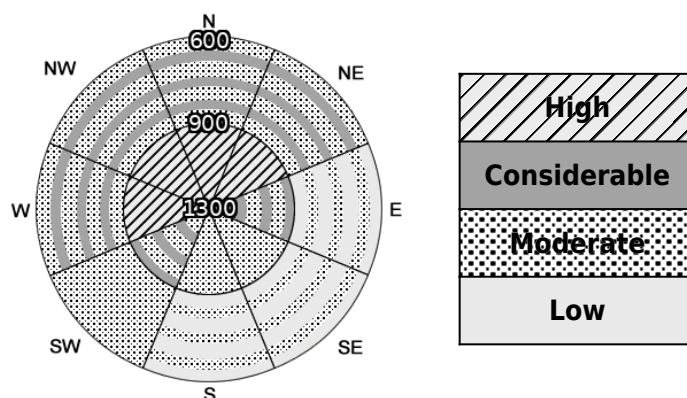

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface of the snowpack will re-freeze and stability in all locations will improve. The onset of snow showers will develop weakly-bonded windslab accumulations on East to South aspects above 750m and some selected North-East facing gullies where avalanches are likely. Newly formed cornices will be prone to collapse. Very good stability in all wind-exposed locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Persistent and heavier snow showers overnight becoming lighter during the day. Cold, freezing level 600 metres, but temperatures easing along with snow showers as freezing level rises to 900 metres in afternoon. Strong North West winds throughout.

Comments

Highly variable precipitation and temperature regimes at the moment. Wintry again for a time.
