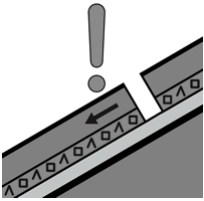


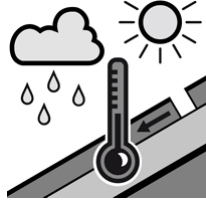

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 02/01/2013

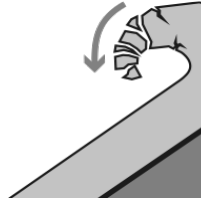

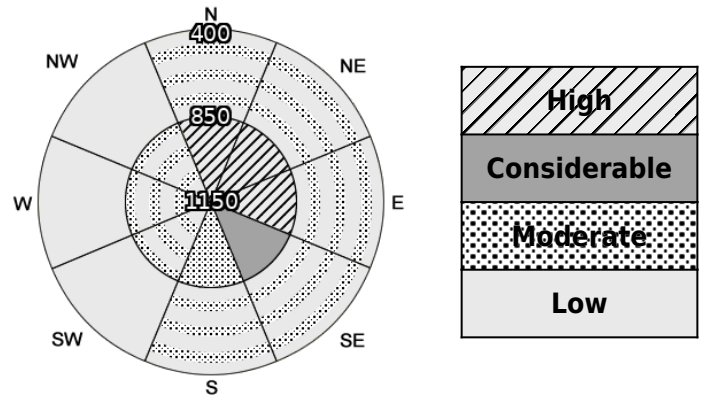

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of high instability will occur as heavy rain and rising temperatures saturate the snowpack. Avalanches and cornice collapse will occur in sheltered areas such as gullies and on slopes with a North-West through East to Southerly aspect mainly above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Precipitation will initially fall as persistent snow overnight before turning to heavy rain at all levels as freezing levels rise well above the summits. Heavy rain will continue through the day. Strong winds will fluctuate between the West and the South.
