





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The initial snow will add to the substantial deposits which already exist on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 meters. Avalanches are likely in these locations as the freezing level rises and the snowpack goes through a period of instability. Wet snow instabilities will remain on these aspects through the day. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Later in the night precipitation is expected. Initially this will fall as snow on the tops before soon turning to rain at all levels. The rain will continue through the day. The freezing level will rise to 2800 meters.

Comments

Turning very mild tomorrow with summit temperatures of at least plus five, and expected to stay mild for a good few days.
