





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and diminish slowly. However the dense snowpack will generally remain stable throughout, apart from localised instabilities that remain in the moderately stable, soft, windslab deposits on mainly Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Light rain at all levels overnight with a freezing level at 1200 metres. In the day the freezing level will rise well above summit heights. Winds will be strong Westerly with some rain showers.

##### Comments

Mild for the next few days some sign of cooling after weekend.
