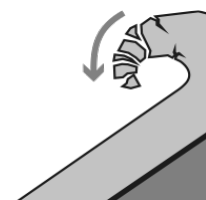

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 04/01/2013

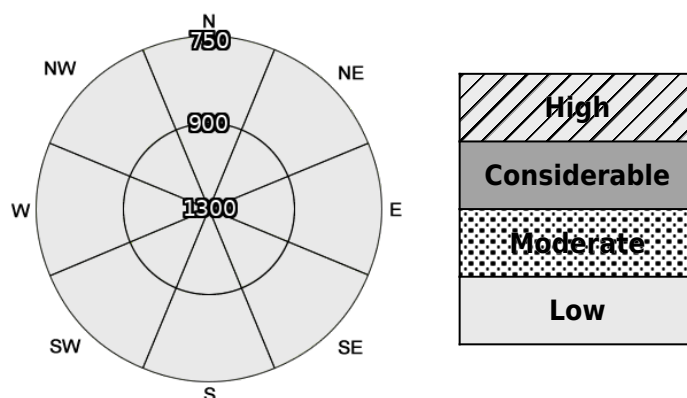
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable on all aspects and at all altitudes; however minor surface instabilities could affect steep sun exposed slopes and remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with moderate West backing South-West winds. The freezing level will be well above the tops.

Comments

Winds expected to decrease with a temperature inversion affecting the Cairngorms - could be as warm as plus 12 degrees on the tops tomorrow!
