



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain firm, well bonded and stable at all levels and on all aspects. Some snow traces will form later in the day but will be insignificant.. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, light Westerly winds, dry with a freezing level lowering from summit levels to 950 metres. In the day the freezing level will be around 900 metres and winds will become North then light Easterly with some snow flurries later.
