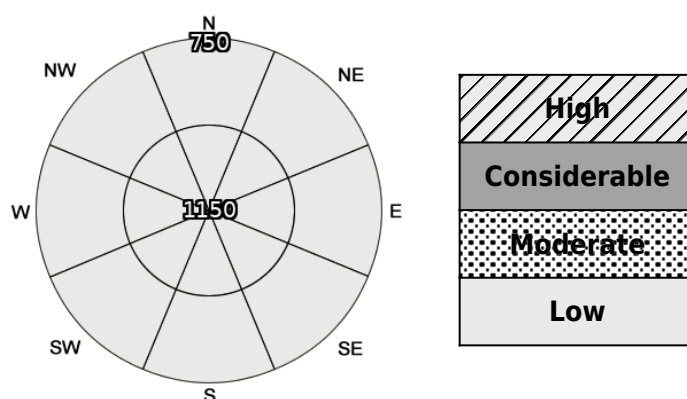

The existing snowpack will remain frozen and stable. Any fresh deposits are expected to be very shallow and limited. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A few light snow showers are possible during the period. Light to moderate winds will be from the South or South-East. The freezing level will drop from 900 metres to 800 metres.
