

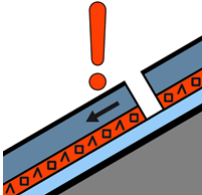

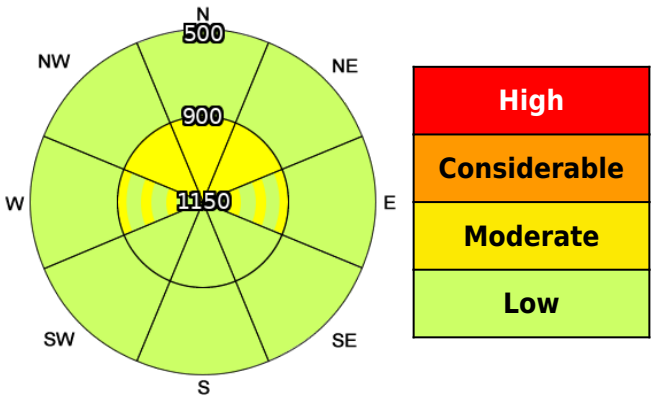
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will develop mostly on North-West to North-East aspects mainly above 900 meters. Some cross loading will take place especially around summit gully exits and corrie rims. Other aspects will have localised instabilities. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, heavy snow showers above 200 metres with moderate Southerly winds, during the day further snow showers and the Southerly winds will increase in strength. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.

Comments

Snow forecast for Sunday and Monday. Then high pressure will build to give a mainly dry but very cold, settled spell of weather during rest of the week.
