

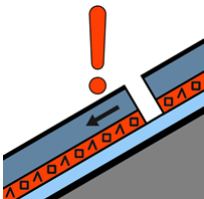

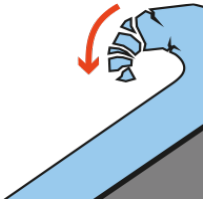

Wind Slab



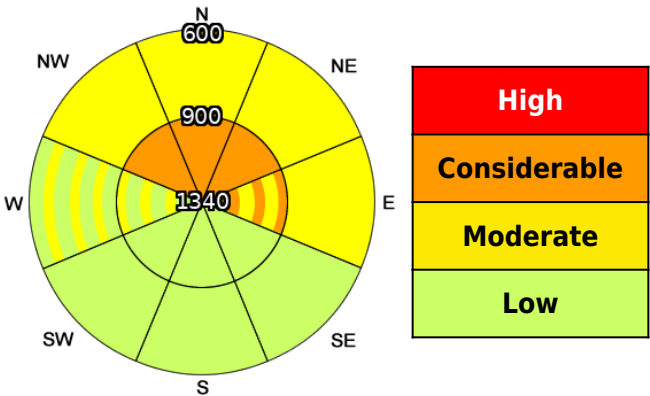
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of weakly bonded windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, these mainly on North-West to North-Easterly aspects above 900 metres where avalanches are likely. The fresh deposits will be particularly unstable where they overlie the existing hard snow-ice. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Persistent snow overnight is expected to ease through the day. The freezing level will be around 500 metres. Moderate winds will be from the South.
