

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 15/01/2013


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old patchy snowpack will remain well bonded and stable in all areas. Some localised accumulations of moderately well bonded soft windslab will be present in sheltered locations on Easterly aspects mainly above 1000 metres, wind protected hollows and corrie rims being most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, winds will be light Easterly with some snow showers above 200 metres. During the day it will be dry with light South-Eastertly winds. Freezing level 300 metres.

Comments

Remaining generally dry but cold and clear
