Accumulations of unstable windslab will be present on many steep North-West to North-East aspects mainly above 900m. The greatest instabilities will be on scarp slopes and in sheltered gully and exits. Other aspects will have localised unstable deposits and cornices soft, and unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain dry through the forecast period with moderate Southerly winds, freezing at all levels.
