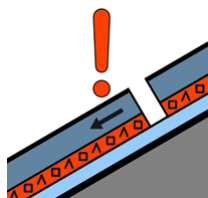
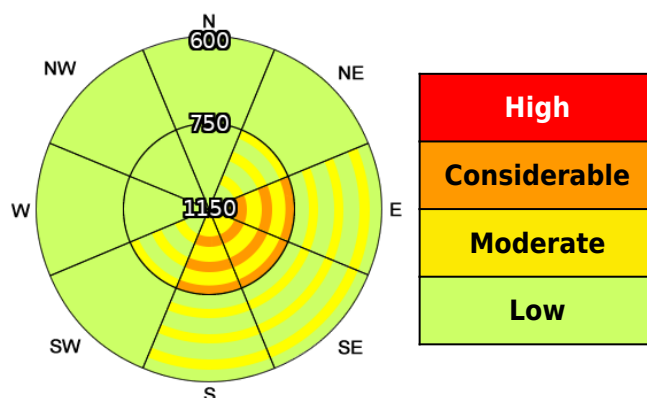

Consolidation will take place slowly. Poorly bonded windslab will be found on mainly East to South aspects above 750 metres, with greatest amounts present in more sheltered locations at higher elevations. Soft cornices will be present above these features. Wind scoured slopes will be firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Settled conditions will continue with light Southerly winds and no precipitation. It will remain cold, freezing at all levels.
