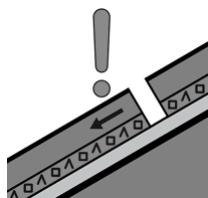

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 16/01/2013

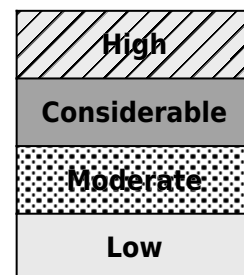
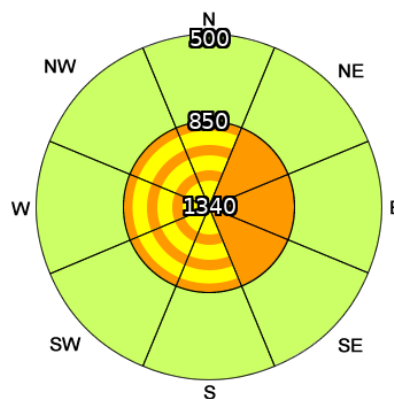
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected during the period as dry settled conditions prevail. The snowpack will continue to consolidate at lower elevations but cold temperatures will maintain localised instabilities in pre-existing windslab deposits on North through East to South East aspects above 800m. Good stability in most other places. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold, settled and dry with freezing to all levels,. Winds will be generally light and Southerly.
