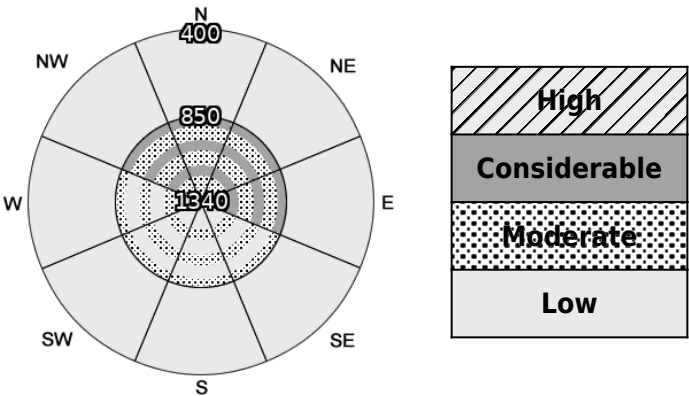

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable snow will be present on many steep North, North-East and East aspects above 850 metres. During the day, unstable snow will also form on sheltered North-West aspects. Greatest accumulations will be on scarp slopes and gully exits. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers with increasing South-East winds. It will remain freezing at all levels.
