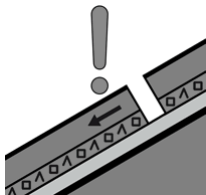
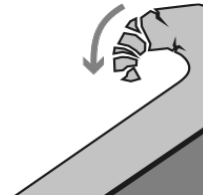
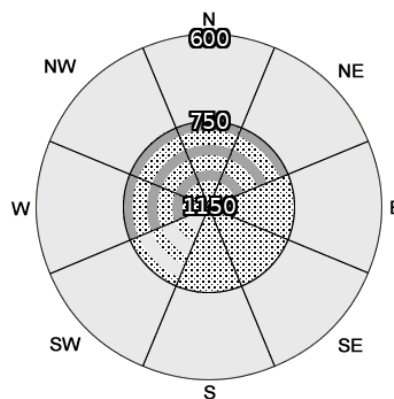

Re-distributed deposits will rapidly form poor to weakly bonded accumulations in very sheltered locations on West through North to North-East aspects above 750 metres. Fresh cornices will start to form. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain very cold with just a trace of fresh snow forecast. Strong Southerly winds overnight will strengthen and back South-Easterly during the day.
