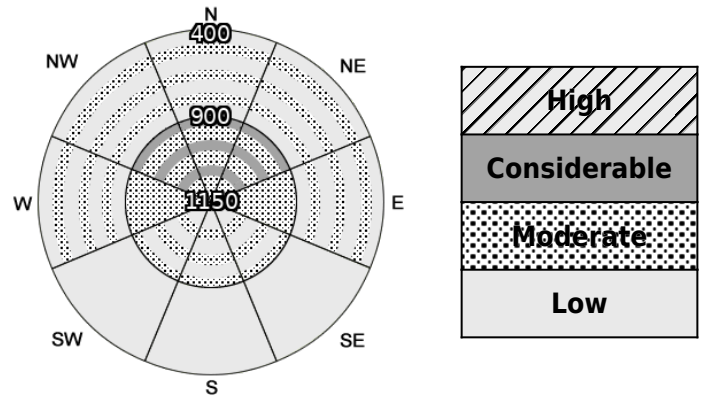
Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The strengthening wind will start to redistribute the existing soft snowpack. The redeposited snow is expected to be poorly bonded on steep slopes where it accumulates on top of the existing snowpack. This will affect mainly North-West to North-East aspects above 900 meters. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

The cold conditions will continue through the period with temperatures remaining below freezing at all levels. Southerly winds will back to the South-East and strengthen. Precipitation is not expected.

**Comments**

Strong winds expected on Thursday and in-particular on Friday.
