

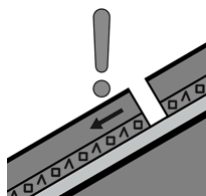

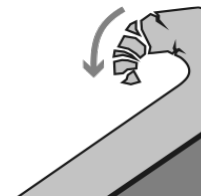

Wind Slab



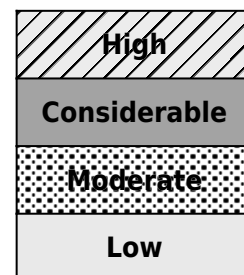
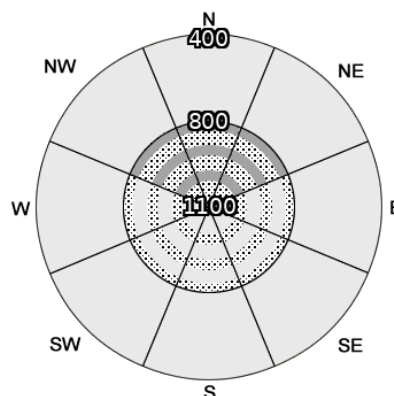

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised instabilities will persist as moderate to strong winds re-distribute lying snow to develop pockets of windslab above 800 metres primarily on North-West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres. Some cross loading will also affect steep gully flanks and high sheltered lee locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

Remaining cold and dry but with increasing mod to strong South-Easterly winds.
