

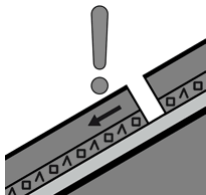

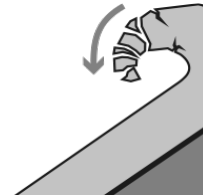

Wind Slab



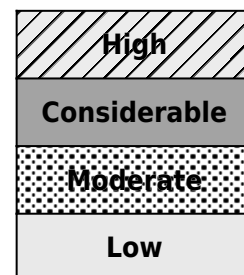
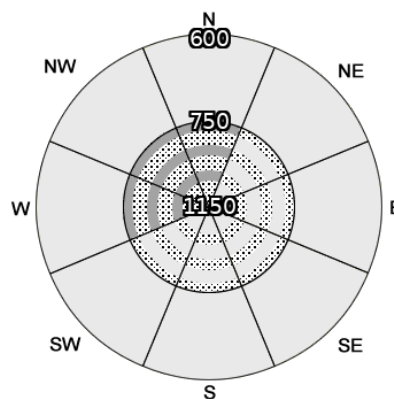
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poor to weakly bonded windslab will continue to develop on mainly West to North aspects above 750 metres. Very sheltered locations, such as gully exits and corrie rims will hold greatest amounts, with depth increasing through the day. Soft cornices will form. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with strong South-Easterly winds. After a mostly dry night, snow showers will become heavier and more frequent later in the day.

Comments

Variable snow distribution at present. Stability will deteriorate through the day.
