

Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting will continue, loading existing weaknesses within the snowpack and avalanches are likely mainly on steep West to Northerly aspects above 950 metres. Areas of instability will affect adjacent slopes due to cross loading. Cornices will continue to build and be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain very cold with occasional snow showers at all levels on moderate South-East winds.
