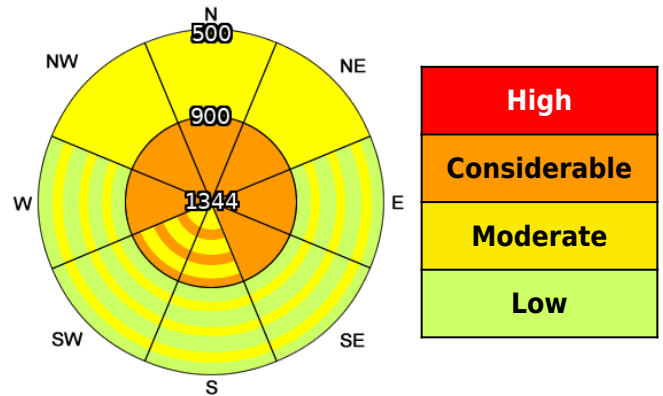
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of new windslab will develop and overlie existing windslab deposits in sheltered locations on West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. Many exposed areas will remain scoured and will hold little snow. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with a freezing level of around 200 metres. Moderate winds will be from the East-South-East. There will be some snow showers through the period.

Comments

Although existing windslab feels very hard and strong, it is not well bonded to the underlying snowpack/ground.
