

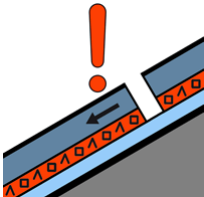

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 22/01/2013

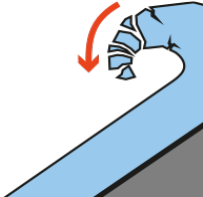
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



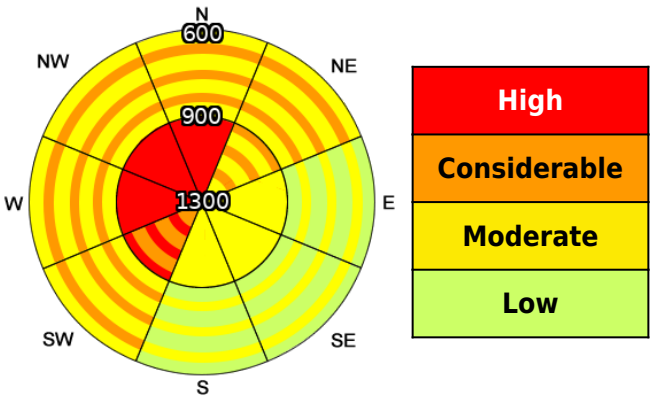
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Heavy drifting will continue to load existing weaknesses within the snowpack. Avalanches will occur mostly on steep South-West through West to Northerly aspects above 900 metres. Instabilities will affect other aspects due to cross loading. Cornices will be weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing very cold with further outbreaks of snowfall overnight, heavy at times, turning more showery through the day. Strong East-South-East winds are expected to ease.
