

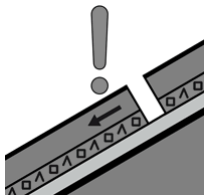

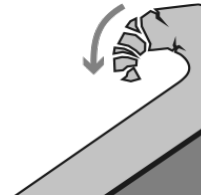

Wind Slab



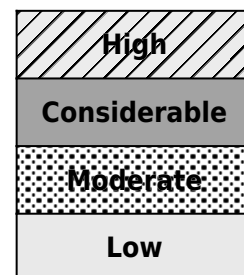
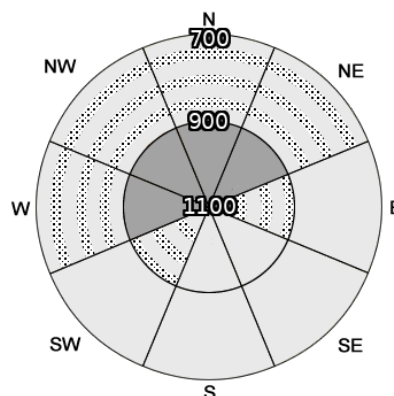

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. Stability will be very good on all recently wind-scoured slopes and gullies. Accumulations of weakly bonded soft and hard windslab will be present on all steep West through North to North-East aspects above 900 metres. Newly formed cornices will be weak and be prone to sudden collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Occasional outbreaks of snow overnight becoming drier during the day. The East-South-East winds initially strong will ease slightly during the day. Cold temperatures persist.
