

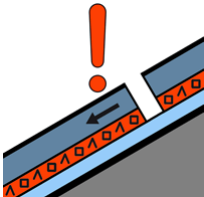

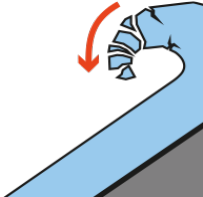

Wind Slab



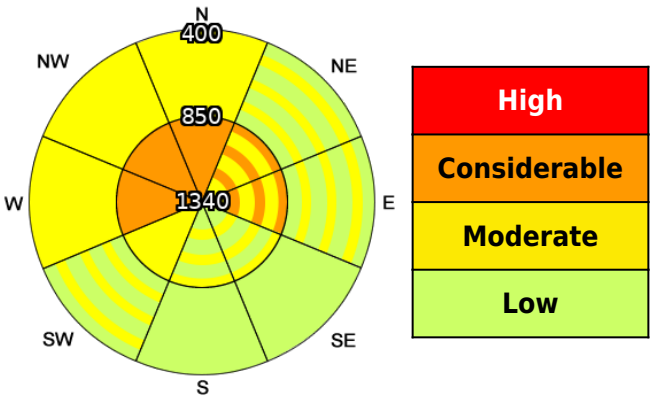
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of both hard and soft windslab will be present on many aspects above 800m. In many locations, this windslab will be poorly bonded to the underlying snow layers. Greatest accumulations of unstable snow will be on West, North-West and North aspects. Localised areas will also be present on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers will continue with moderate South-Easterly winds.
