

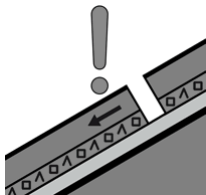

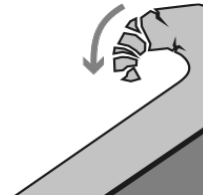

Wind Slab



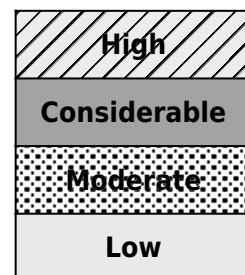
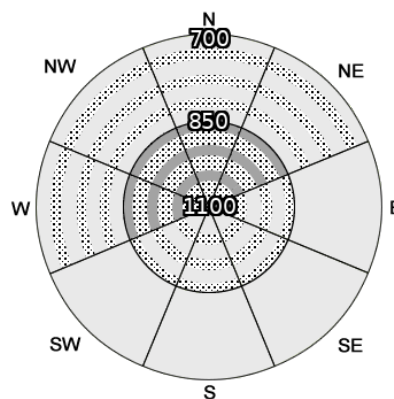

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised instability will persist mainly on steep West through North to North East aspects above 850m. Any drifting will bring about new, soft and moderately bonded windslab development on steep North West to North East slopes and gullies above 850m. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

Remaining cold and dry with light to moderate South Easterly, later Southerly winds.
