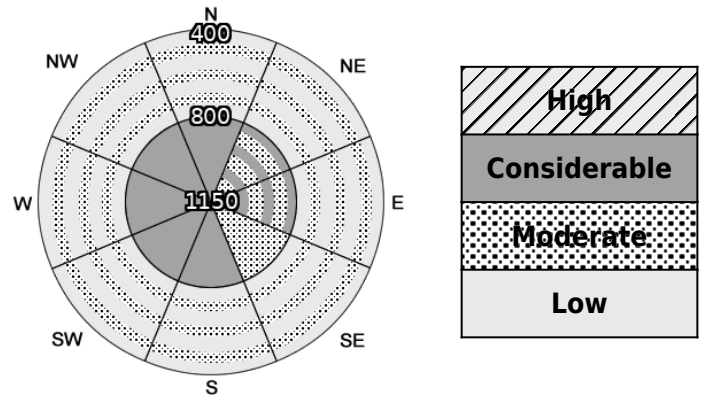

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The complex and variable snowpack will persist. Areas of poorly bonded unstable windslab will remain mainly on West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects are also affected due to cross loading. Fresh cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to remain cold and dry, with moderate South-East veering Southerly winds. The freezing level will rise to around 200 metres during the day.

Comments

Windslab deposits, both hard and soft, often overlie a soft weak layer beneath.
