

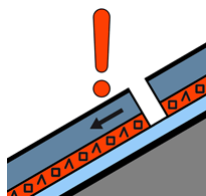

Wind Slab



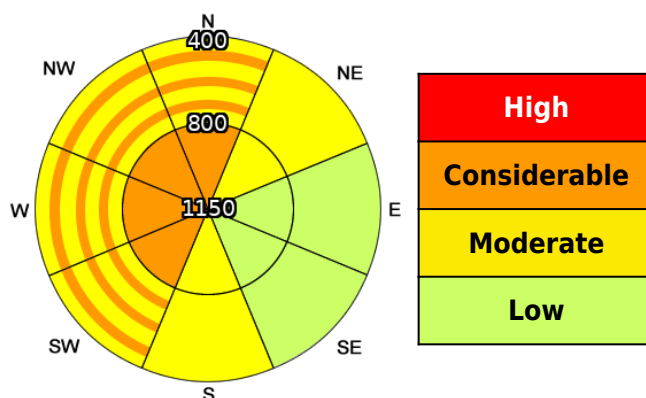
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of poor to weakly bonded windslab will be found mostly on South-West through West to Northerly aspects above 800 metres. Localised unstable areas will also be found on other aspects. New cornice developments will also remain unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with some light snow flurries and light winds from the South.

Comments

The snowpack is very variable. Very easy to go from no snow to deep snow over a few metres, careful route finding is required.
