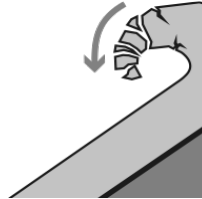

Wind Slab



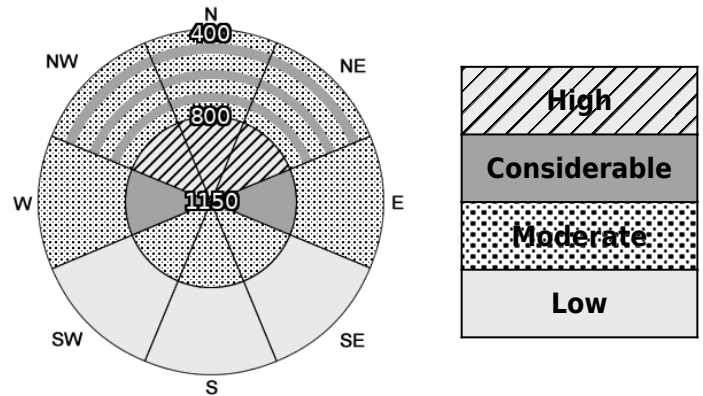

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large area of unstable windslab will be deposited on North-West to North-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanche will occur. Other aspects will be affected with unstable windslab due to cross loading. Soft fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate overnight snow will be followed by heavy snow during the day. The freezing level will rise to around 400 metres. Strong winds will be from the South.

Comments

A wild and snowy day with poor visibility expected on Friday. Care should be taken if venturing into the hills.
