

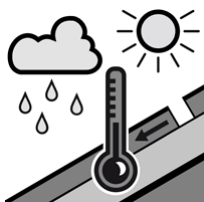

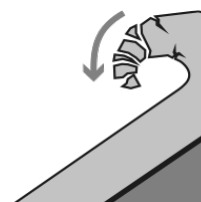

Wind Slab



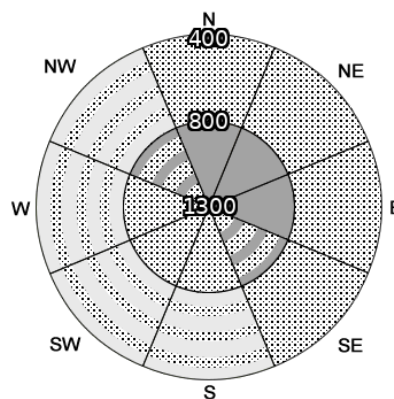
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Very poor stability expected on North to East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Sharp rise in temperature expected when snow will turn rapidly to rain at most levels. All recently formed cornices will become wet and weak. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold overnight with more snow showers. Much heavier precipitation, with snow turning to rain at most levels, expected during the afternoon. Winds will be strong South-Westerly.

Comments

Freezing level rising to 1200m before falling to 500m during Monday evening.
