

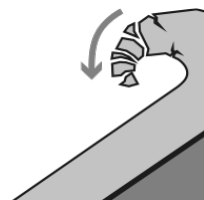

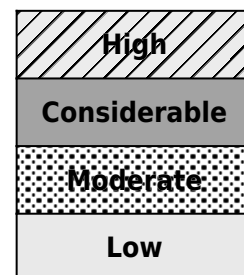
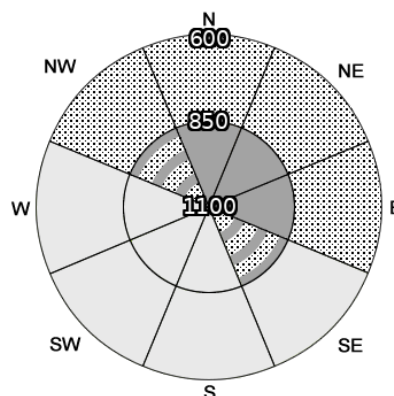
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poor stability on very sheltered North to East aspects above 850m where avalanches are likely. Windslab build up expected to be rapid in these locations. Some localised lee slope scouring possible in very strong winds. Much better stability on windward slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

More snowfall overnight and later in the day with very strong West, later South West winds. Freezing level fluctuating to just above and just below summits.
