


**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The existing snowpack will continue to refreeze above 800m and be stable. Snow showers will produce fresh areas of unstable windslab in sheltered locations. Accumulations are likely to be localised but main accumulations will be on sheltered North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900m. Wind scoured snow slopes will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will lower this evening to around 800m with snow showers above this altitude. Winds will remain strong to gale force from the west.
