

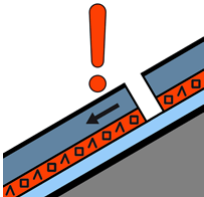

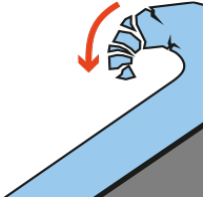

Wind Slab



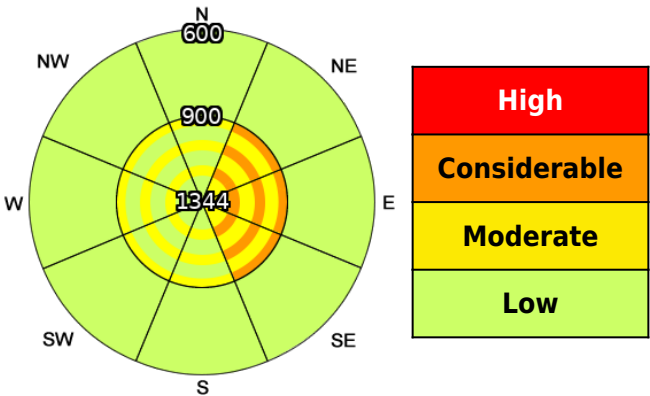
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh areas of unstable windslab will continue to develop in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900m. Exposed old snow will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will ease overnight and become light. Snow showers will continue above 600m.
