

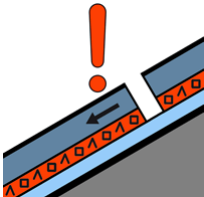

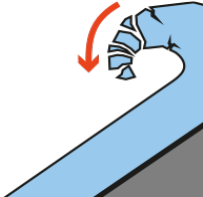

Wind Slab



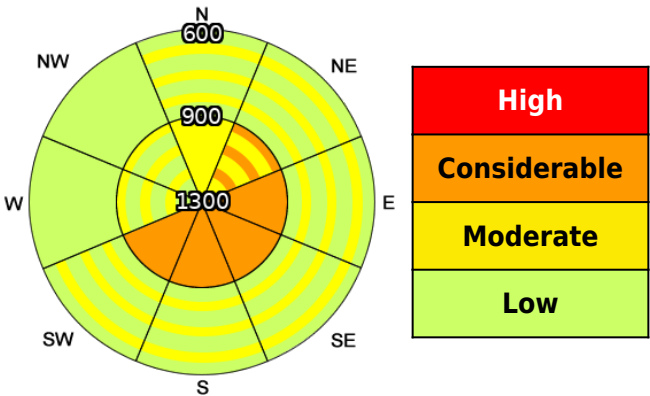
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded accumulations of windslab will mostly lie on East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Instabilities will also affect other aspects especially around corrie rims and gully tops on steep North and North-East facing slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers overnight will clear to leave a dry day. Strong North winds will ease a little and back to the North-West. The freezing level will be at 400 metres.
