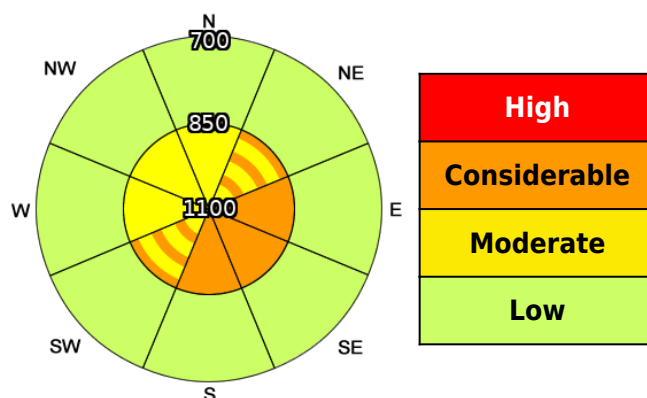

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stronger winds will redistribute snow as weakly stabilised windslab on to steep East through South to South-West aspects above 850 metres where avalanches are likely. Worst affected areas will be the top of gullies and steep corrie backwalls. All recently wind-exposed locations will be scoured and show better stability. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast and it will remain cold with stronger North, later North-West winds.

Post Face plastered with soft snow . All ledges, ramps and gullies carrying a lot of unconsolidated snow on Friday. At least 3 groups of climbers backed off starting routes in Coire Ardair today.
