

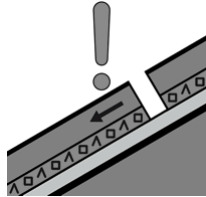

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 04/02/2013

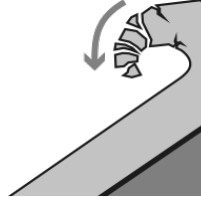
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



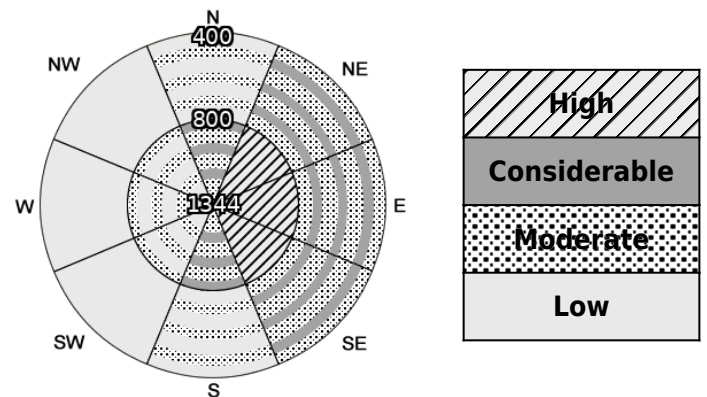
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of poorly bonded windslab will be deposited on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches will occur. Other aspects will be affected by cross loading. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Some very wild weather conditions are expected. There will be frequent heavy snow showers and very strong Westerly winds. The freezing level will be at 200 metres.

Comments

Some very wild conditions, with winds gusting 120mph on the tops, are expected on Monday.
