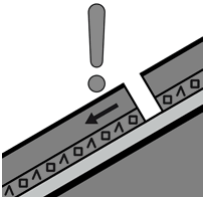

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 08/02/2013

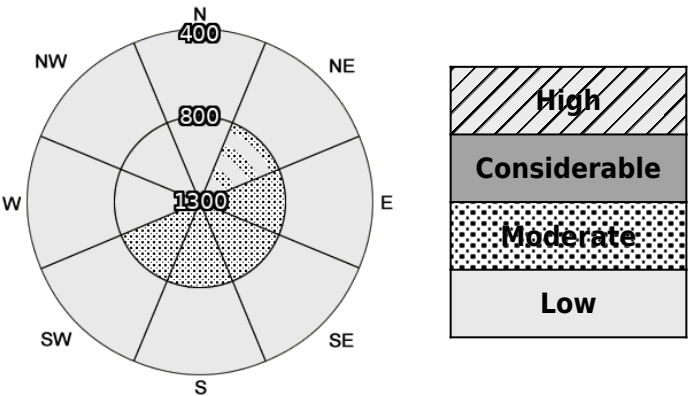
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to improve in stability but moderate weaknesses will remain in the snowpack on mainly steep East through South to South-Westerly facing locations above 800 metres, steep and convex terrain being most affected. Some new thin accumulations will form on these aspects during the day. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day winds will be moderate North-Westerly with occasional snow showers above 400 metres throughout the forecast period. Freezing level 600 metres.

Comments

An improved snowpack situation - but large areas are scoured, firm and icy, generally calm wintry outlook.
