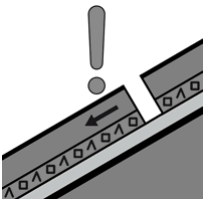


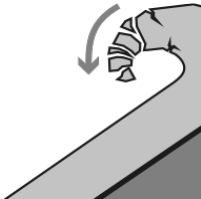

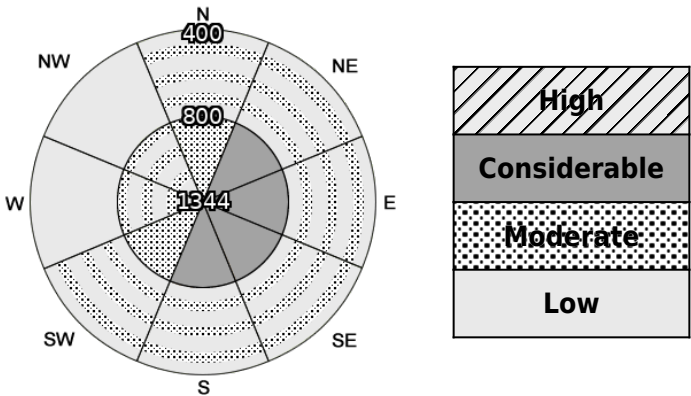
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of windslab will remain on North-East through East to South aspects above 800 metres. This will remain poorly bonded to the underlying snow ice. During the afternoon some fresh deposits are expected in these location. Some fragile cornices will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry night and morning, some light snow is expected above 700 metres during the afternoon. It will turn a bit milder with the freezing level rising to around 1000 metres through the day. Light to moderate winds will be from the West.
