

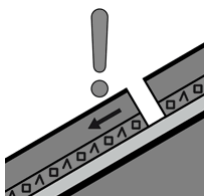

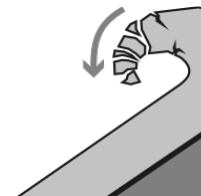

Wind Slab



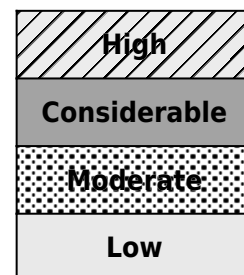
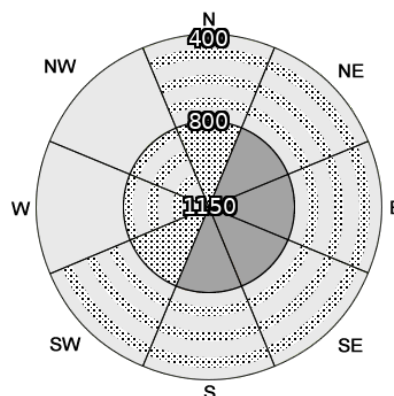
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of poorly bonded windslab will persist mainly on North-East through East to South aspects above 800 metres. During the afternoon fresh windslab will be deposited on these aspects. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry overnight and in the morning, with some light snow above 700 metres during the afternoon. Winds are expected to be strong North-Westerly overnight, light Westerly during the day. The freezing level will rise to around 1000 metres during the day.
