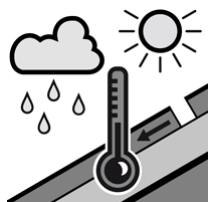


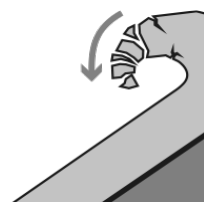

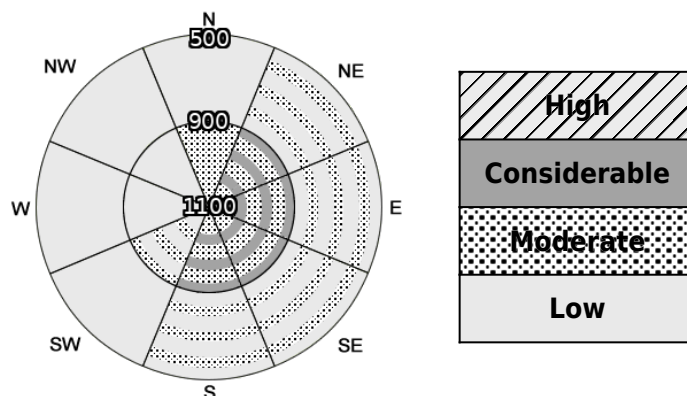
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Much milder temperatures will induce localised wet snow instability on North-East through East to South aspects above 900m. All cornices above these locations will be weak and prone to collapse. Better stability at lower altitudes and on slopes of other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Little precipitation is forecast but the freezing level will be at or above summits overnight and during the day. Winds will be light to moderate Westerly, later South-Westerly.

Comments

Light precip may be rain or snow depending on location of weather front but much milder summit temps forecast.
