

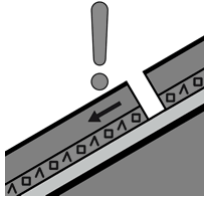

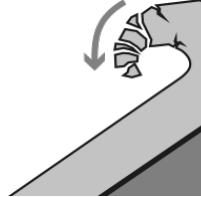

Wind Slab



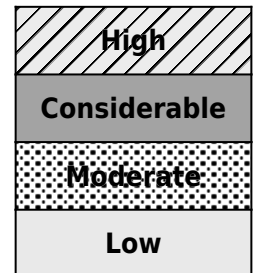
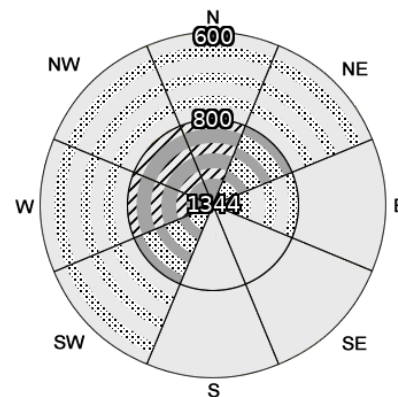

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of fresh unstable windslab will continue to form in areas sheltered from the South-East winds. Greatest accumulations will be on steep West, North-West and North aspects above 800 metres. Avalanches will occur in these locations. Other sheltered aspects will also be affected. Wind scoured slopes will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-East winds easing slightly during the day. Overnight snow showers clearing by morning.
