

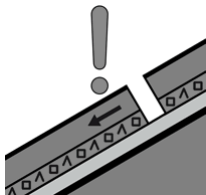

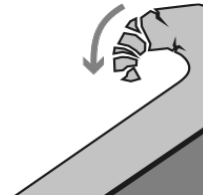

Wind Slab



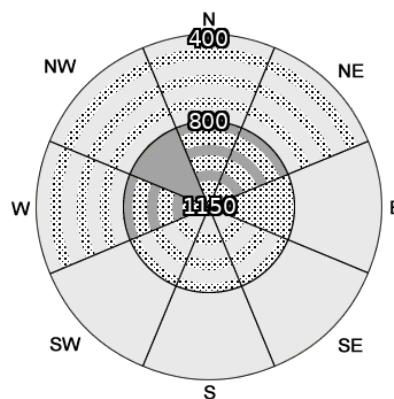
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of deep unstable windslab will be on mostly Westerly through Northerly to North-Easterly aspects above 800 metres. On other aspects the snowpack is mostly moderately bonded with areas exposed to the winds scoured and stable. At lower altitudes localised instabilities will be found on steeper terrain features. New soft cornices will develop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The winds will be moderate from the South-East veering Southerly during the day. There will be light snowfall overnight and during the day.
