

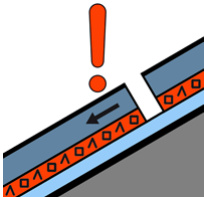

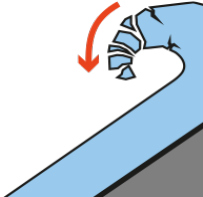
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



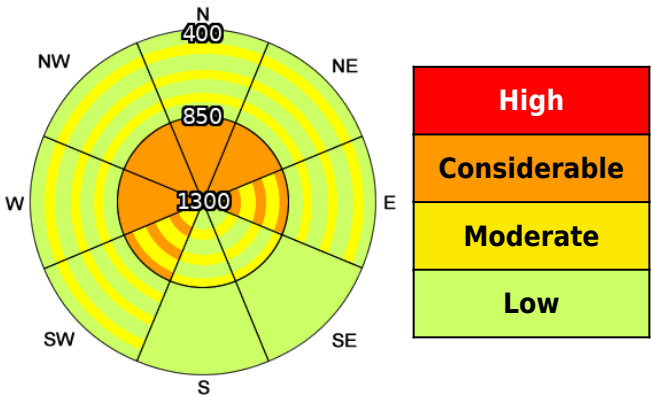
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further drifting with windslab continuing to load existing weaknesses within the snowpack. Avalanches are likely on steep West through North to North-East aspects above 850 metres especially around corrie rims, gully tops, scarp slopes and crag aprons. Instabilities will affect other aspects due to cross loading. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Occasional snow showers are expected. Moderate to strong South-East winds will veer to the South. The freezing level will be at 400 metres.
